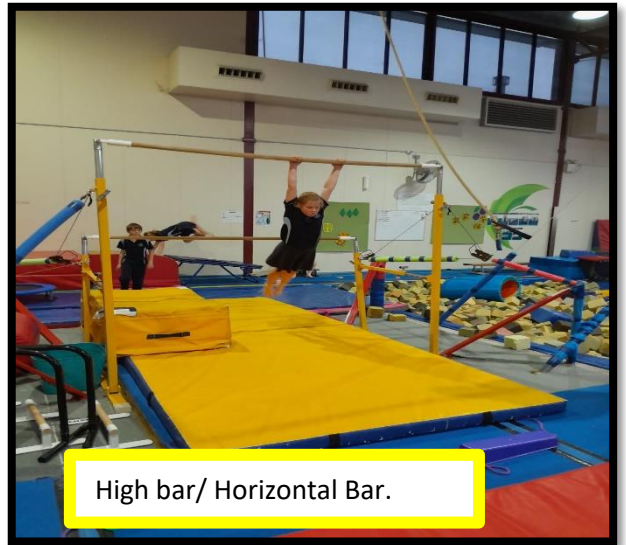

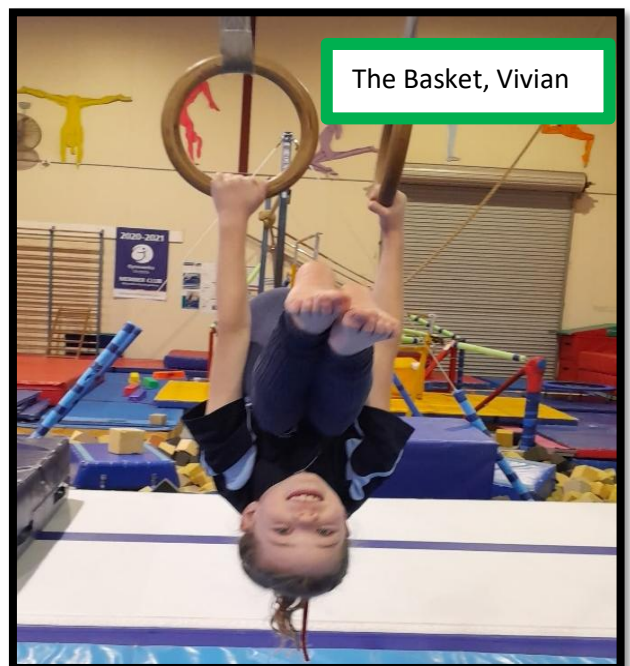

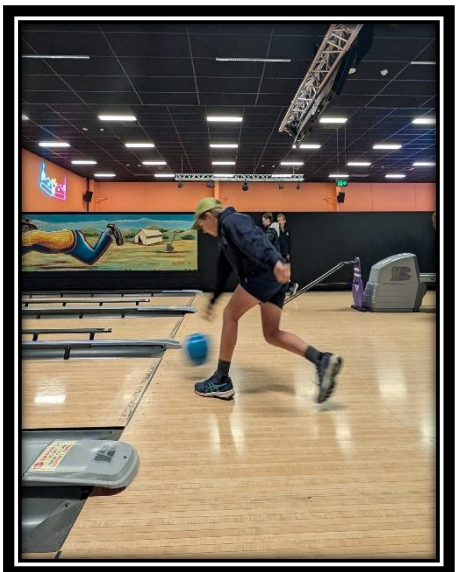
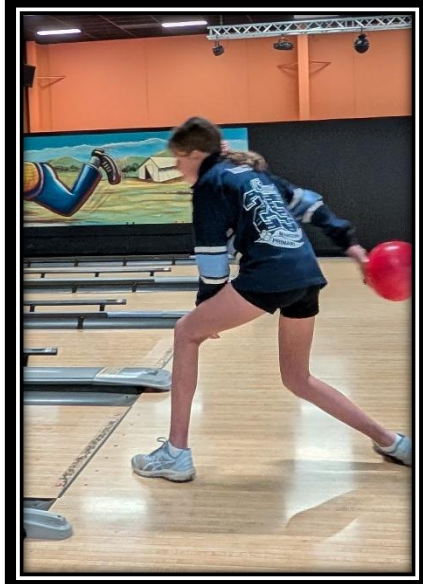
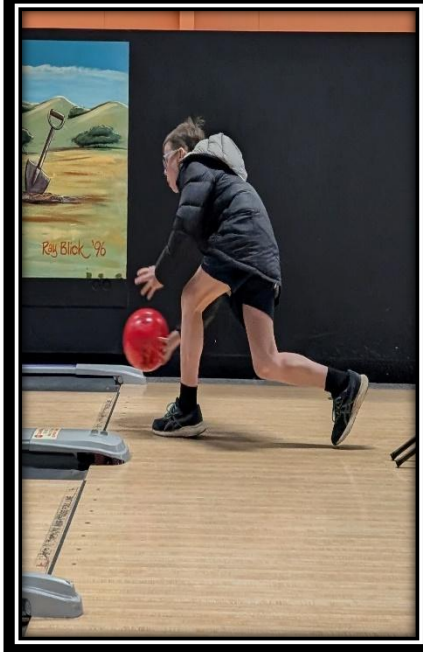
Floor stretching

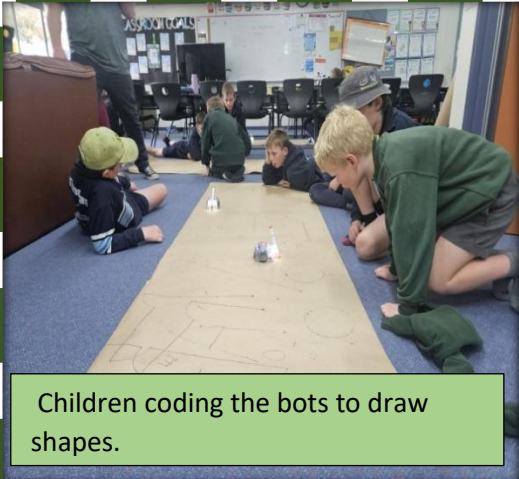
